Voter Registration

To register to vote, you must be a citizen of the United States, 18 years or older by the time of the general election, and a resident of your precinct for 30 days prior to the general election. Registration locations include the Marion County Board of Voter Registration, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Township Trustee Offices, Indianapolis/Marion County Public Library branches, and online at www.indianavoters.com. Voter registration ends 29 days before the election. If you change your name or your address, you MUST change your voter registration.
